

CLEANING FOR MONKEYPOX PREVENTION

CLEANING THE ROOM

- Clean from top to bottom, and work your way from clean to dirty
- Wear appropriate PPE (gloves, mask, long sleeves and pants)
- Dispose of waste as your normally would

HARD SURFACES

- Include interior surfaces of furniture and appliances
- Use an EPA-registered disinfectant in accordance with manufacturer's instructions

LINENS AND TOWELS

- Try not to shake dirty towels or bedding
- Wash items as you normally would

SOFT FURNITURE AND CARPET

- Disinfect with an appropriate disinfectant for soft surfaces
- Use an EPA-registered disinfectant in accordance with manufacturer's instructions

Monkeypox can spread between people through direct contact with a rash, body fluids, or through coughing and sneezing during periods of prolonged face-to-face contact.

It may also spread from contact with items that have been in contact with body fluid from an infected person.
